COVID-19 Pandemic Impact

• Decreased Rehab High Occupancy and Rehab Low Occupancy due to MOH directive to temporarily cease all non-urgent and non-emergent surgeries and procedures from Apr. 20, 2021 to gradual reintroduction starting May 19, 2021 and from Jan. 5, 2022 to gradual reintroduction starting Feb. 1, 2022 as well as lingering low occupancy from previous facility outbreaks. Also impacted by infection control requirements, including the following: temporary hold on admissions to multiple units due to declared and suspect COVID outbreaks at HDS from Jun. 13-Jun. 27, 2021; Jan. 9-Jan. 25, 2022; Jan. 28-Feb. 6, 2022; and Feb. 10-Feb. 20, 2022; ongoing 24-48 hour delays for admissions awaiting negative COVID swab results and limitations on patient mobility and ability to make room for new admissions who had received both doses of a COVID vaccine).

Impact on Rehab High occupancy is being mitigated by the new HDS Post COVID Rehab program launched Feb. 3, 2021.

• Surplus (Deficit) impacted by reduced revenues resulting from MOH directive to temporarily cease all non-urgent and non-emergent surgeries and procedures from Apr. 20, 2021 to gradual reintroduction starting May 19, 2021 and from Jan. 5, 2022 to gradual reintroduction starting Feb. 1, 2022.

• "Would recommend" and "Enough information" inpatient survey results unavailable from Dec. 29, 2021 to Jan. 21, 2022 due to temporary suspension of patient advisor services.
