This poster reported the results of a refinement to our Pod Model on 1 East to include a Designated Stroke Pod. The Stroke POD Planning Committee rolled out this change in April 2018. Data from April 2018-April 2019 demonstrated positive results in access to rehabilitation, therapy intensity, patient outcomes and bed flow.
