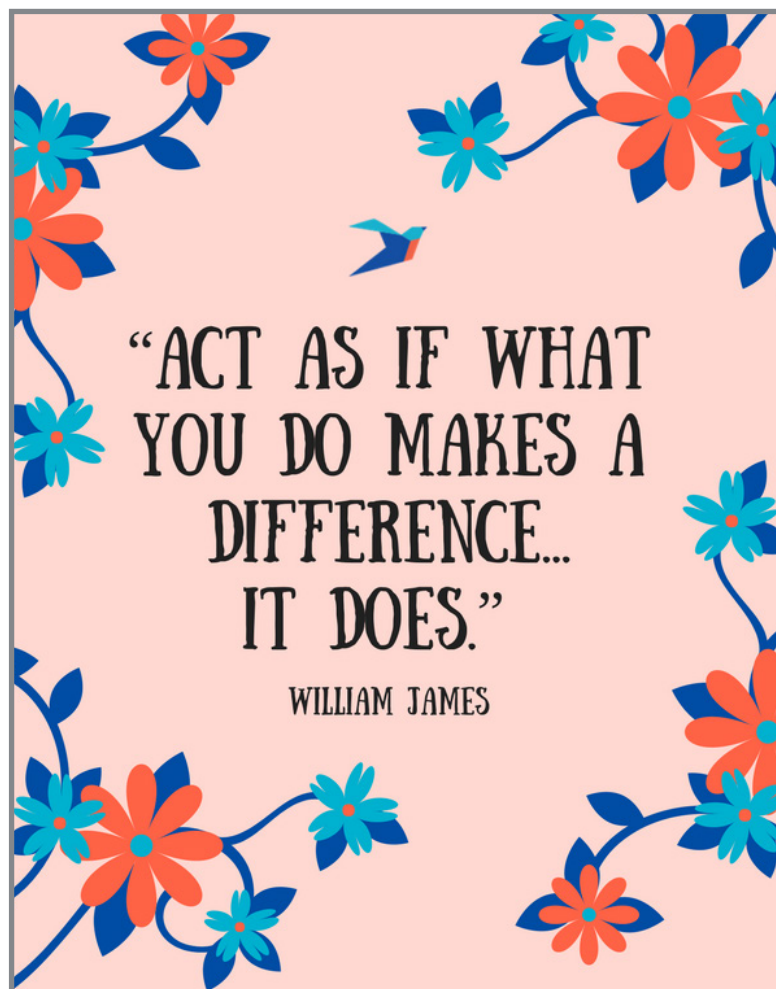

NIAGARA COMMUNITY FOUNDATION GIVES BACK

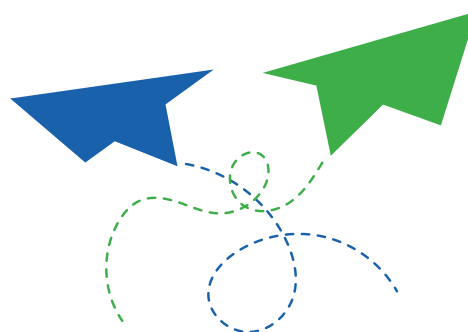
