GUIDELINES FOR A SAFE HOSPITAL VISIT

Hotel Dieu

Shaver

AS A VISITOR, YOU MUST:

- Wear a mask for the duration of your visit
- Pass screening in order to gain entry. Should a visitor fail the screening process, that visitor will not be permitted into the hospital
- Proceed directly to the patient's room, upon screening completion. Visitation is restricted to the patient's bedside only. Upon exit, all visitors must sign out at the screening desk
- Sanitize your hands before and after your visit
- Maintain physical distancing at a minimum of 2 meters (6 feet) between any person at all times

Food and drink is not permitted in the hospital at this time.

Do not touch anything in the patients room.

Use this time to visit with your loved one, they have missed you!

DAILY VISITATION BLOCKS

BLOCK ONE: 11:30 am to 1:00 pm BLOCK TWO: 5:00 pm to 6:30 pm

* patients can have one visitor per visitation time block *

VISITATION GUIDELINES DURING COVID-19

- Bring a mask and wear it at all times, while in the hospital
- Patients can have 1 visitor per visitation time block and must be over 18 years of age
- No pets allowed in the building at this time
- Temporarily, the Dieu Drop In Cafe is not accessible to visitors
- Visitors are not permitted to bring in food or drink at this time.
- No passing of gifts/personal items or cell phones during visit with the patient
- Washrooms are available for visitors at the Inpatient front entrance on the ground floor only
- Hotel Dieu Shaver's visitation policy is subject to change at any time

HOW TO CORRECTLY WEAR A FACE MASK





Hand rubs should contain 70–90% alcohol. Use hand rub when you cannot see dirt on your hands. If you can see dirt, clean your hands with soap and water.
